

End of Key Stage 2 SATs Results

Children at Lady Lane Park school take part in the end of Key stage 2 SATs in Year 6. Lady Lane Park School is completely non-selective, which makes our academic success even more pleasing.

Prior to the academic year 2015-16, end of Key stage 2 expectations were that children should have reached level 4 by the end of KS2. Level 5 was a great achievement and showed the child was working at a high level. Level 6 was a rare achievement in primary school, with only the top 1% of 11 year olds attaining this level. Levels were replaced in 2015-16 by a statement of working at the expected standard or working towards the standard, with the expected standard now being equivalent to the previous Level 5. There is no classification for exceeding at KS2 for English Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation or Mathematics.
