The sticker cards continue to be a hit with all the children involved and the children are again collecting stickers this term, eagerly aiming for at least 10 stickers so that they will take part in the end of term treat.

Alongside the treats the children can also work towards their bronze (25), silver (50), gold (75) and platinum honours (100) certificates which will be presented in assembly when the relevant combined sticker total is achieved.

The demerits system also continues, with the children having very clear ideas of what will cause them to receive a demerit and the consequences for their actions. The children are given warnings for behaviour that is not acceptable. If 3 warnings are received in a day, a demerit will be given and the child will spend a period of their free time with Mr Walker, where they will be asked to think about their behaviour. A letter will also be sent home for parents to sign so that you are fully aware of any demerits and can discuss them with the class teacher or Mr Walker, the Rewards and Sanctions Coordinator.
