## **GDPR**

If your email inboxes are anything like mine, it cannot have escaped your notice that the 'GDPR' is coming. As a consequence, all those institutions which hold personal data of yours, need to alert you to the changes.

The General Data Protection Regulation arrives on 25 May 2018 and is an update to The Data Protection Act (1998). The world has changed a great deal since 1998 and some of these changes (e.g. social media and online shopping) mean that information about us is being stored in more places by more people. This increases the possibility of security issues. As such the GDPR makes clear how personal data should be safely used and stored.

Naturally, the administration of a school requires a keen understanding of sensitive situations and management of sensitive information or data. As such, there is a clear legal basis for much of the data we hold, given the statutory requirements for schools.

The point of GDPR is to make sure sensitive or private information about you and your children stays safe. Whilst it is similar in spirit to the current Data Protection Act in many ways, there are a few administrative, legal differences, so we need to make a few changes in order to ensure we remain compliant.
