### **Fee Increase**

Following a review of our annual charges Alpha Schools will be increasing our fees by 3% from September 2018. There has not been a fee increase since January 2017 and these increased will come into effect on your Autumn Term fees, there is now no charge for any school milk. If your child would like milk, please have a word with your child's classteacher and they will make sure some is available. The infants have theirs at morning break and the juniors have theirs with their lunch. Our Registration Fee remains the same, our refundable deposit is £250.00 and our crèche fees will be chargeable at £3.50 per half hour session. The crèche fees include breakfast and a drink in our before school crèche and a light snack and drink/fruit in our after school crèche.
