Further to my Holiday Club at Lady Lane Park School last year, I am offering the above dates for 2020.

My ethos is primarily to encourage children to step away from 'screens' and to get as much fresh air and exercise as possible, whilst learning new skills in the process. Ultimately, this is the children's holiday and I want them to have fun! I run a 'relaxed, easy going' club with great emphasis on safety, kindness and fair play towards each other.

Miss Holmes and Mr Rawling will also be joining me. Parents are welcome to contact me either by email (nickhindle@live.co.uk) or by mobile (07972-841012) to discuss any aspects of the holiday club.

Activities proposed:

Sports: eg. cricket, football, tag rugby, tennis, fun races and dodgeball.

Arts and Crafts: eg. painting, drawing, colouring, painting stones, making jewellery, decorating masks, bun decorating and more.

Creative Play: den building using boxes and sheets, water play, creating scenes with plastic animals and wooden bricks etc.

Old fashioned Games: Hoopla, egg and spoon race, hopscotch etc.

Indoor Activities (in case of rain): we have plenty of board games including bagatelle (a firm favourite), arts and crafts activities, 'chilling time' with a movie ONLY when children are tired, full size table football and much more.

Occasional trips to the Prince of Wales park to make dens and have picnics and play games.

Children's Choice

Children will be allowed at certain times during the day to choose their own activities, so for example if they don't want to make jewellery, they can build a den or play games. I will have many alternatives for the children to choose from at this time.

Each year, over 150 children are diagnosed with cancer in Yorkshire.
