Dear Parents

I write to inform you of a fee increase which will be effective from the Autumn Term 2019. Every effort has been made to keep the increase to the absolute minimum whilst ensuring the continued excellence of the educational service provided.

The new fees from September 2019 will be as follows:-

Lower Kindergarten (session)	£25.50 per half day session (8.30am – 11.30am <u>or</u> 12.30pm – 3.30pm)
Lunchtime Provision	£10.00 (11.30am – 12.30pm)
Kindergarten – UVI	£2752.00 per term (Autumn/Spring/Summer)
Crèche (charged in arrears)	£3.50 per half hour session (no fee increase) Early Bird – 7.30am – 8.30am Night Owl – 3.30pm – 6.00pm

All full time fees include lunches (we do not provide Halal food but a Vegetarian option is on offer daily). Milk is available to all children at no extra charge.

Childcare Vouchers are accepted as part payment of fees until the term in which a child becomes five; after that they may only be used for crèche costs.

Please note that payment is due no later than the first day of each term.

The preferred method of payment is by direct transfer to our bank account.

My name is Nick Hindle and I am a former pupil of Lady Lane Park School. I continued my education at Woodhouse Grove School and then obtained my Sports Coaching BA (Hons) degree at University of Central Lancashire. Since then, I have been working for various organisations including 4 months in a child care centre in Perth, Australia. I currently work for Bronte House School in the PE Department and I am also Head Coach for the Ryan Sidebottom Cricket Academy.

Last summer, Mrs Earl invited me to help her during one of her holiday clubs; subsequently I ran my own sports camp following this. My ethos is primarily to encourage children to step away from 'screens' and to get as much fresh air and exercise as possible, whilst learning new skills in the process. Ultimately, this is the children's holiday and I want them to have fun! I run a 'relaxed, easy going' club with great emphasis on safety, kindness and fair play towards each other.

I will be running a Holiday Club this summer at Lady Lane Park School, based at the Lodge. Miss Holmes and Mr Rawling will also be joining me. I welcome any parents who wish to contact me either by email (nickhindle@live.co.uk) or by mobile (07972-841012) to discuss any aspects of the holiday club.

Activities proposed:

Sports: eg. cricket, football, tag rugby, tennis, badminton and every child's favourite DODGEBALL!

Arts and Crafts: eg. painting, drawing, colouring, painting stones, making jewellery etc.

Creative Play: den building using boxes and sheets, water play, creating scenes with plastic animals and wooden bricks etc.

Old fashioned Games: Hoopla, egg and spoon race, hopscotch etc.

Indoor Activities (in case of rain): we have plenty of board games including bagatelle (a firm favourite), arts and crafts activities, 'chilling time' with a movie ONLY when children are tired, full size table football and much more.

Children's Choice

Children will be allowed at certain times during the day to choose their own activities, so for example if they don't want to make jewellery, they can build a den. I will have many alternatives for the children to choose from at this time.
