### **Walking To School**

It is approaching the time when some LVI/UVI pupils are beginning to make their own way to school. If you are planning to let your child walk to school unaccompanied, we need to be are aware so our procedures can be applied to ensure they are safe.

We would like <u>you</u> to email school to let us know the days your child may be walking to school without an adult. **You only need to do this once and we will keep this on record, you don't need to tell us each day.** A list of pupils walking will be in the relevant register, so that whoever is registering the class that day is aware of the arrangement.

If your child is not coming to school due to illness, appointments etc, please let us know on the day as soon as possible.

If you decide to allow your child to go home unaccompanied at the end of the day, we will need to know this too but the responsibility for your child getting home safe will be yours.

Some pupils have asked if they can bring a phone to school so they can use this in case of emergency on their way in to school. If you would like your child to do this, please ensure they are using this only in an emergency and, in order to stay safe, they do not use the phone for listening to music, going online or taking pictures whilst they are walking to school. They will need to hand the phone in to the office when they arrive at school as they are not permitted to have this with them through the day.

# Activities proposed:

Creative Play: den building using boxes and sheets, water play, creating scenes with plastic animals and wooden bricks etc.
