# Singing Opportunity Young Voices Concert, Tuesday January 14th 2020, Sheffield FlyDSA Arena, daytime and evening.

After the success of this year's visit to Young Voices we have booked 21 places to sing at the above concert in January 2020.

In brief, Young Voices (YV) describe their concerts 'This is not just any ordinary choir concert – your children will sing with between 5,000 - 8,000 other children in a massive arena near you. Young Voices uses the best sound, lighting, and production teams, making your concert as spectacular as any other arena concert. Your choir will sing a variety of music with amazing artists, from all different backgrounds.'

The special guest artists for 2020 will be: **Ruti**, who won The Voice in 2018. She will be singing her single 'I Couldn't Do It Without You' with the Young Voices choir; '**The Shires**', they have two gold-certified record-breaking albums, have the fastest selling UK country album in history and are the first UK act to win an American Country Music Award; **Tony Hadley**, who is returning to Young Voices for the second year. He described his experience at YV2019 as 'one of the most rewarding things I have every done'.

- We have a limited number of places and are inviting <u>all Juniors</u> who love singing to consider whether they would like to participate in this event.
- At the concert we will sing approximately a dozen songs chosen by YV. The words will be
  distributed to participants by the end of September at the latest and will need to be learnt off by
  heart beforehand. There will be opportunities for songs to be practised at home using online
  resources and participants will be expected to join in with rehearsals on Mondays in school
  3.30-4.30pm, in November and December.
- On the day we will travel to Sheffield in the school minibus/a small coach for which there may be a small charge. Singers will travel to Sheffield leaving school mid-morning. There will be a rehearsal at the arena in the afternoon and the concert is from 7pm 9pm (we will get back to school very late that evening).
- Young Voices requires all children to wear either their own plain white t-shirt or a YV t-shirt with logo which may be purchased through school nearer the time (cost approx. £12.50).
- Family & friends can attend the concert as audience members audience tickets cost approx. £21 each & will be available via school nearer the time.

## **Office Administration**

Parents divorced or separated, or who hold joint custody or interest in a child's progress, are welcome to apply **in writing** to the office for a copy of their child's report. In such cases, the original report is usually forwarded to the parent responsible for the payment of the school fees.

Please note our weekly bulletin can always be found our website www.ladylaneparkschool.co.uk Bulletins are emailed out every Friday. If you change your e.mail address please remember to tell Mrs Wright so she can amend your records. This also applies to mobile telephones, so please let us know if you change yours during the course of the year to enable us to contact you via our text messaging service, parent consultation booking service and payments systems.

Please make sure you read the bulletin, any changes to clubs will be published here and all current and up to date information is in it!

## **Payment of Fees**

Please note that the preferred method of payment is by transfer directly to our bank account, as detailed in the letter with your invoice. However if you can only pay by cheque, this must be sent in a sealed envelope marked for the attention of Mrs Wright in the school office. Credit or debit card payments can be made by contacting Mrs Wright who can set this up for you via School Money. All queries regarding fees or payment methods should also be directed to Mrs Wright.

Fees are due on or before the first day of each term.

#### Notice to Leave

As per our Terms & Agreement and via the Acceptance Agreement which you have all signed when you registered your child with the school, please note the following:-

- If you intend to remove your child from Lady Lane Park School at the end of the Autumn Term, 2019 you should <u>already</u> have given notice on the last day of the previous term i.e. Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2019.
- If you intend to remove your child from Lady Lane Park School at the end of the Spring Term, 2019 you need to give notice on the last day of the previous term i.e. Wednesday 18th December, 2019.
- If you intend to remove your child from Lady Lane Park School at the end of the Summer Term, 2020 you need to give notice on the last day of the previous term i.e. Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2020.

Notice must be in writing to Mr Saunders by letter and/or e.mail. If you fail to submit the correct notice you will be liable for a term's fees in lieu of notice, all notices will be acknowledged. If you do not receive confirmation please get in touch with the school and speak to Mrs Wright as this indicates it has not been received.

#### Medicines

If your child is unwell and requires prescribed medicine, please make sure you fill in a Medicine Form obtainable from the school office. If your child attends Early Bird crèche, Mrs Simmonite also has some forms available. Without the permission form, we are unable to give any medicines.

If your child has any medicines in school on a permanent basis, a Medicine Form also needs to be filled in and renewed **each term**. This is **your** responsibility – so please ensure medicines are clearly named and all the appropriate paperwork is with Mrs Wright.

## **Sickness Policy**

In an important effort to keep all children and staff as healthy as possible, – our rule re children who have been unwell, particularly with sickness and/or diarrhoea, is that you **must** keep them away from school for a minimum of **48 hours** after the last episode. This helps to stop the spread of infections!

#### **School Hours**

The school day begins for all children at 8.40am and ends at 3.30pm. The main school doors will not open until 8.30am and children should be supervised by a **parent** until that time. A member of staff will be on duty in the playground from **8.30am - 8.40am**. The classroom doors are open for both Lower Kindergarten and Kindergarten at 8.30am.

## The bells the bells!!! The morning parent's bell and the children's bell!

Just before 8.40am we ring the school bell – this is the parent's bell and is the signal for all parents/grandparents to wave good bye to the children and leave the playground. A few minutes later, we ring the bell again – this is the children's bell and is their signal to 'line up' ready for their class teachers to take them into school. I'm sure you'll soon get the hang of it – but if not – then the children will be happy to remind you.

## **Lower Kindergarten**

Please notify the school office or liaise with the Lower Kindergarten team if you wish to increase any of your child's sessions. An increase in sessions can be made at **any time** during the school year.....we always try and accommodate all children where we possibly can.

The only time we will not be able to accommodate you is if the session is already full due to staff/children ratios.

#### The Homework Folder - LKG - UVI

The school folders for Lkg - Form 3 are priced at £6.50 and the folders for Forms 4 – UVI are priced at £8.50. All items can be purchased from the School Office. Please do not let your child attach any key ring/'embellishments' to their folder!!

## Uniform

Other than Kindergarten and our new children entering school for the first time, all children should wear their full **summer** uniform until October Half Term. Please ensure that all items of uniform are <u>clearly</u> labelled for there will be a uniform check, so don't be caught out! Please ensure that name tapes are clearly visible – the sewn in ones are certainly the best. Please don't forget that caps for the boys and hats for the girls are worn by all children from Kg – Form 5 inclusive. If you purchase an item of uniform from our New to You shop, please ensure that all former name labels are removed!

#### **Caps & Straw Boaters**

Caps and straw boaters are **not** worn by Lower & Upper VI children but all other children in school are expected to wear theirs please on entry and exit from school.

## **Badges**

House badges, available from the School Office at a cost of 50p and are worn on the school sweater or cardigan. Badges should be worn at all times.

## Crèche

May I remind parents that we have a fabulous crèche facility. The cost is £3.50 per half hour which includes a drink and snack.

Early Birds is run by Simmonite and Mrs Morgan and is available from 7.30am at The Lodge. We offer cereal, toast and drink in our 'breakfast club' for those children who are in Early Birds between 7.30am – 8.15am.

Night Owls will be run by Mrs Simmonite and Mr Rawling and is held every evening at The Lodge from 3.30pm until 6.00pm. Those children in the Junior Department wanting to complete homework tasks will have a quiet corner designated for this purpose upstairs at The Lodge.

For those children who attend crèche and are then going on to a 4.30pm club or activity, or who will be staying well beyond 4.30 pm, we shall be offering a sandwich to help 'put them on' until they get home for their tea.

Mrs Simmonite and Mr Rawling will be assisted by Mrs Morgan and James Morgan. The children in Lower Kindergarten - Form 3 will be based in Lower Kindergarten's room with the junior children using the upstairs room as usual.

Prompt collection of children at 6.00pm is expected. Crèche mobile phone no. 07528 401694. Please note, the crèche facility will be withdrawn from any family who persistently collect their child <u>after</u> 6.00pm!! Both Early Bird and Night Owl crèche is available to any children at any time, there is no need to telephone the office or pre book any sessions, the facility is there for you to use as and when you need it. The cost for each full term will be billed at the end of each month via School Money.

## Junior School Games Bags - Form 4 - UVI

These can **only** be purchased via the School Office at a cost of £25.00. The school bags are required as a 'games' bag for children in the Junior Department i.e. Forms 4 - UVI inclusive and should only be in school on 'games days'. These will be paid via your School Money account.

The bags are exclusively endorsed by the Australian Physiotherapy Association and are proven to reduce the severity of harmful postural response to carriage of weight and they have a reflective strip for added safety.

#### **Junior Games Lessons**

Please will you ensure that all games kit is brought to school inside the large blue school games bag and not separately in carrier bags or sports bags. Boot bags are the only exception to this.

All children in the junior department will be given a timetable in the first few days, so that you and they will know which day the school games bag needs to be in school.

## Art and Science Overalls for the junior children

These blue overalls should be in school at all times. They really only need to be washed at the end of each half term. Please ensure that they are clearly named, for they are all identical as you know, and a nightmare to track down if one goes missing without its name tape! The overall should 'live' in each individual child's school pump bag.

## **Healthy Eating**

We more than welcome the children bringing a piece of fruit or a healthy snack bar, no chocolate, crisps or anything that needs refrigerating and please remember we are a nut free school. All children are also offered an apple for their morning break. We will <u>always</u> encourage them to drink plenty of water throughout the day and we have drinking water fountains in school.

Please remember we are a **nut free school**, for we have children in school who are severely allergic to nuts.

#### Long trousers for boys in LVI & UVI

Please be aware that these are an option for the boys in L & UVI only, although school shorts can always be worn if desired, especially in summer!

#### The Ornamental Bridge & Pond Area in front of the school

Please do not allow your children to play on the bridge or around the pond – we do not own this area and must respect the rights of the people living in the Mansion. The children are taught to keep to the main path near school - please help us to enforce this at the end of the day when you take your children home. The children know that the pond, the bridge and the surrounding grassy areas are all out of bounds for them – please support us with this vital rule. The pond is not very deep, but potentially dangerous none the less for unsupervised children.
