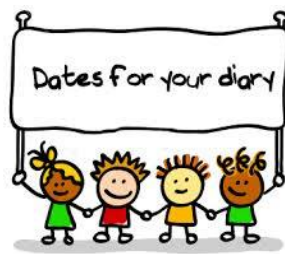
Uniform Change
