All of your hard work and practice has really paid off, Well done everyone!

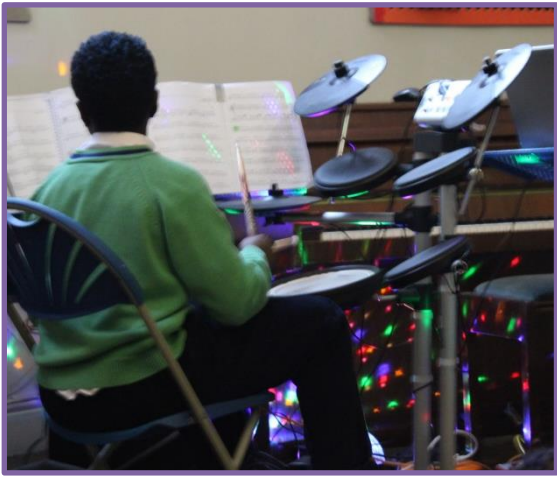

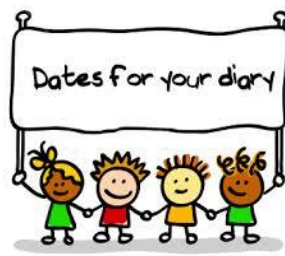
