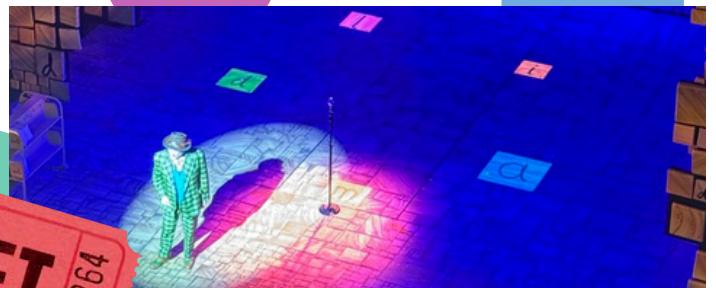

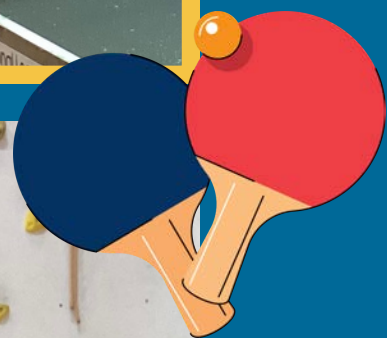

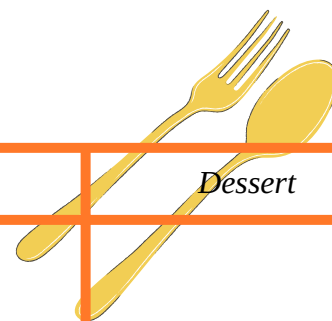
Our next match was against Shakespeare School. They were tough. The boys were great but just couldn't get the crucial points to secure a win so the final score was 8-0.

I'm proud of you all. Miss Raw.



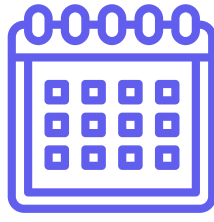
