Kindergarten at Bolton Abbey today

Dear parents,

All our pupils have had a very productive first week back after the half-term break; I have already seen a great variety of activities in school and have been extremely impressed with the enthusiasm of all our pupils. Today, our Kindergarten pupils have been on a trip to beautiful Bolton Abbey and I am looking forward to hearing all about their adventures when they return. On Monday, our UVI pupils are heading off to a living museum at Murton Park near York where they will be experiencing life as a WW2 evacuee.

When you do attend your meeting, please come first to the main school Hall where you will be directed to your appointment. As the weather begins to cool down, it is also important that warm clothing is packed for outdoor clubs and games sessions. I have been delighted to see how smartly pupils have returned in their Winter uniforms, just in time for the change in weather too.
