Dear Parent/Carer

Re: School Fees - 2024/2025

In advance of our Easter Break, I am writing with the school fee structure for the 2024/2025 academic year.

We recognise that school fees are a significant proportion of family budgets and remain aware of the economic climate in the UK. We always aim to keep fees at an affordable level for our families and we strive to keep our fee adjustments to a minimum.

Whilst we always maintain a keen focus on our costs, we are not immune to inflationary pressures. This year, our central focus has been anticipating and mitigating against the much-discussed impact of VAT on our school, should a new Government introduce this measure.

The Independent Sector remains uncertain about the scope of any potential legislative changes in a new Parliament, however we may have to respond more substantially, if a new Labour Government do indeed levy VAT. All I can confidently say is our absolute commitment to keeping fees accessible remains. For clarity, it is the Alpha Schools Group's intention to try to absorb as much of any new school tax as possible, in order to keep true to our ethos of providing accessible fees whilst continuing to provide excellent education for all.

Our fees from 1st September 2024 are as below:

Our annual payment plan option for the coming year remains in place, this provides families with a 4% discount on annual fees for advance payment.


No smart watches, jewellery (only small studs for earrings) and if hair is below shoulder length, please ensure this is tied up.
