### Fees From September 2023

#### Pre-preparatory Department:

Nursery	£28.00 per half day session (8.30am–11.30am <u>or</u> 12.30pm–3.30pm)
Lunchtime Provision	£11.50 (11.30am – 12.30pm)

Infant Department:	Kindergarten - Form 3	£3230.00 per term
Junior Department:	Form 4 - UVI	£3230.00 per term

Registration fee per child (non - refundable)	£100.00 per child
On entering school, a deposit of	£250.00 per child

The deposit of £250.00 is returned when the child enters Form 2 or leaves at the end of the UVI year, subject to no balance outstanding on the account. If a child leaves before Form 2 or UVI, the deposit is non-refundable.

Before & After School Extra-Curricular Clubs	Included in school fees ( <u>ex Dance Club</u> )
Specialist Tuition	Individual Fees (price on application)

All fees are payable for each term in advance and due no later than the first day of term. The tuition fees include books, stationery and a named pump bag. Full time fees are inclusive of lunches and milk. Annual payments attract a 4% discount (contact school for further details).

One full term's notice in writing is required for the withdrawal of a pupil from the school and it is the parent's responsibility to ensure the notice has been received. Such notice must be received no later than the last day of the term before the pupil is to be withdrawn. If insufficient notice is given, an invoice for a full term's fees in lieu of notice will be posted out.

No refund of fees or trip payments is made in cases of absence for illness, or any other cause, as the expenses of running the school and maintaining its efficiency are not in any way reduced by the temporary absence of pupils.

Childcare Vouchers are accepted as part payment of fees until the term in which a child becomes five; after that they may only be used for Crèche costs and Holiday Clubs.

#### Crèche Facility (charged in arrears and invoiced monthly):

'Early Bird' 7.30am - 8.30am	£3.75 per half hour session
'Night Owl' 3.30pm – 6.00pm	£3.75 per half hour session

The fee structure is reviewed on an annual basis.
