He would like to say enormous thanks to everyone who so generously donated to his chosen charity 'St Gemma's Hospice'.



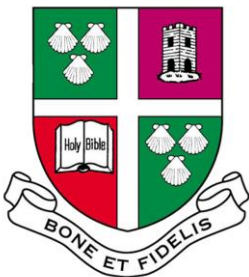

**SCIENCE INVESTIGATION: WHAT DO PLANTS NEED TO GROW WELL?**

Learning Objective/s:  
- To observe and compare green plants grown with and without water and in light and dark places.

I am investigating what plants need to grow well I placed plants in different growing conditions and here is what I observed:

Plant 1 (water but no sunlight) - What happened to the plant that was left in the cupboard?  
The plant grew big and the color is yellow and green.

Plant 2 (sunlight but no water) - What happened to the plant that was not watered?  
The plant was dead.

Plant 3 (sunlight and water) - What happened to the plant that was placed in a sunny spot and watered regularly?  
The plant grew bigger and green and fresh.

What have you found out? What do plants need to grow healthily?  
I have found out that... plants need water and sunlight so it can grow.

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Plant 1 (water but no sunlight) - What happened to the plant that was left in the cupboard?  
Plant number 1 has grown but it has got a yellow color.

Plant 2 (sunlight but no water) - What happened to the plant that was not watered?  
Plant number 2 was a bit dry and withered.

Plant 3 (sunlight and water) - What happened to the plant that was placed in a sunny spot and watered regularly?  
Plant number 3 was great it was green healthy and it grew taller.

What have you found out? What do plants need to grow healthily?  
I have found out that... plants need water and sunlight to be green and healthy.



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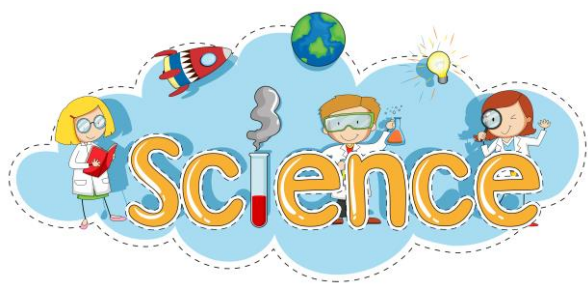
