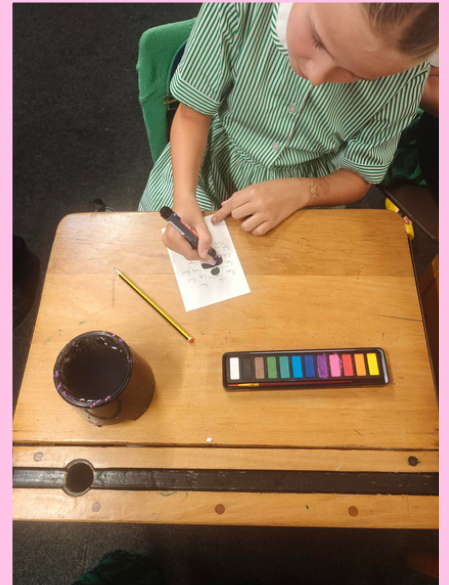

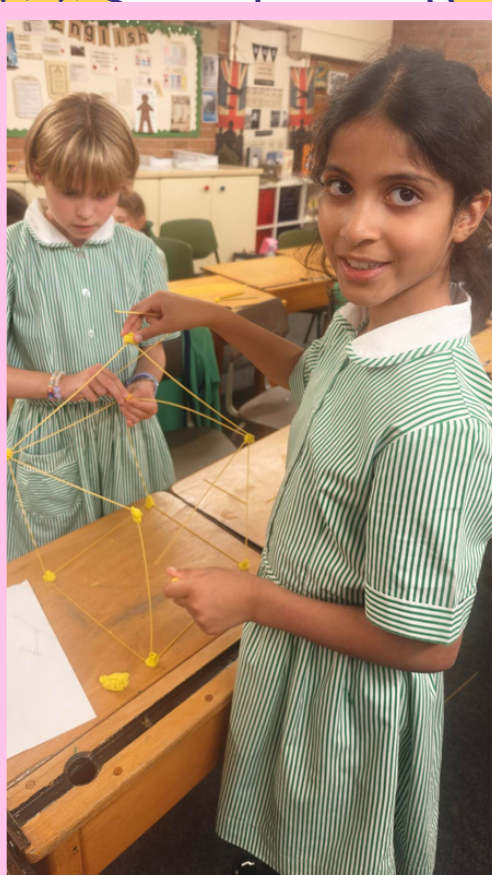
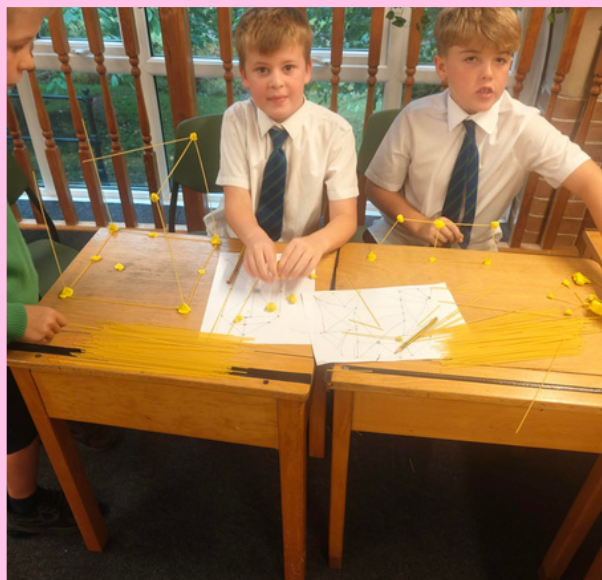


UWI PSHE - What makes us unique?

PSHE stands for Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education. It's a school subject that helps children develop skills and understanding around:

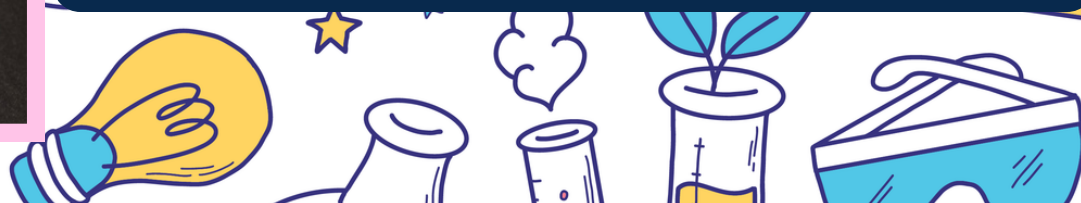
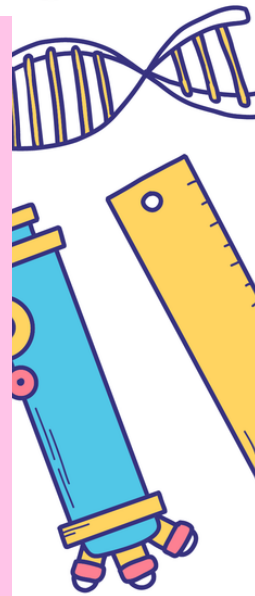
