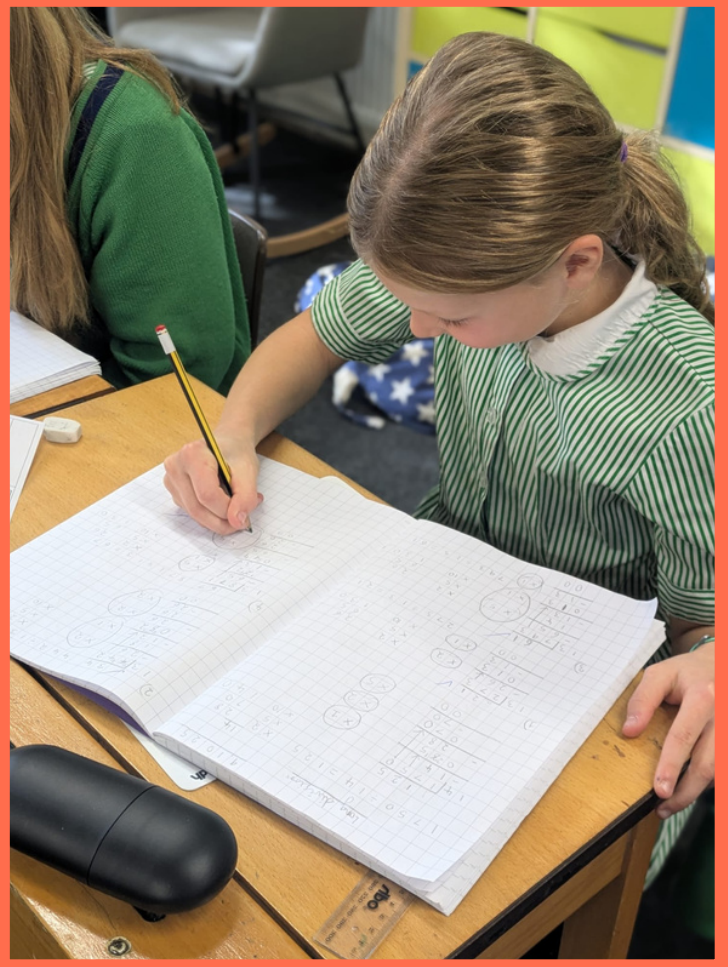

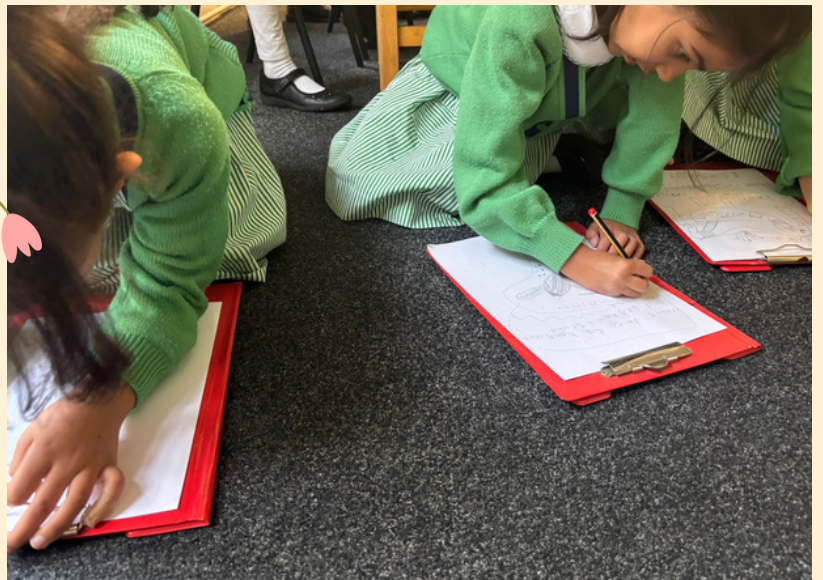
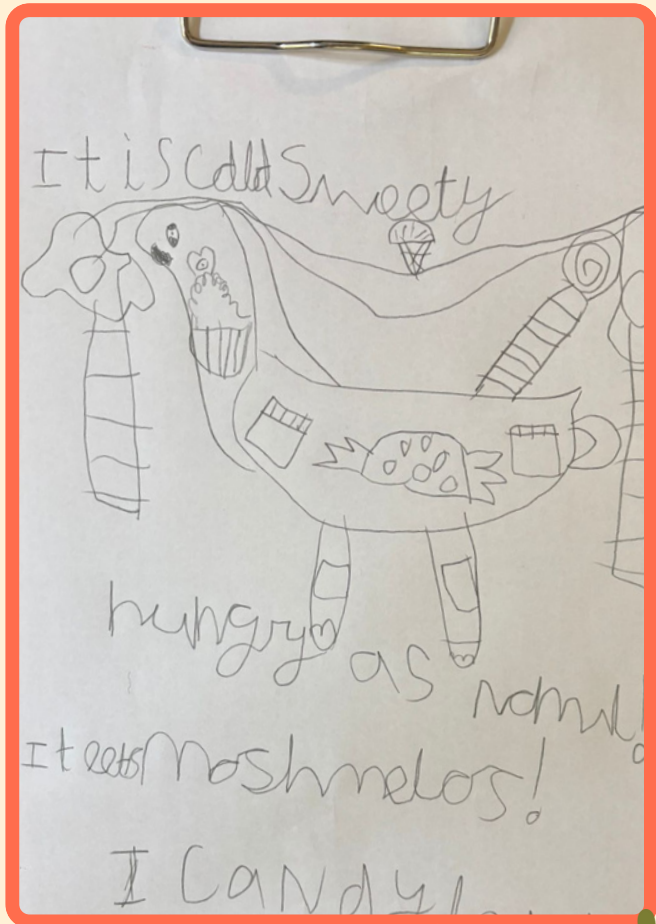

Transport timetables often use 24 hour times. Here is an example of a bus timetable:

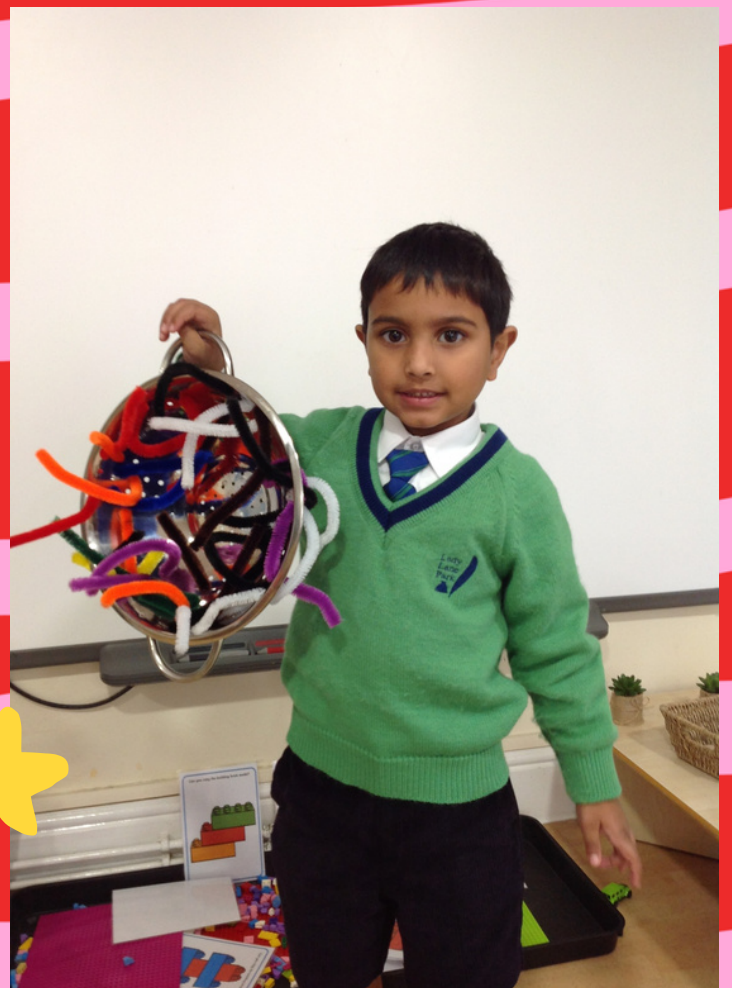
