#### Good afternoon to you all,

It goes without saying that we are all excited to welcome all our pupils back in to school on Monday morning; staff have been busy ensuring that everything is in place for their return. It will be fantastic to see the faces of some pupils who have not been in school since before Christmas. All pupils will return in full uniform and will return to their normal weekly timetable of lessons. Form teachers will post a reminder of the timetable followed in school, including a homework timetable where applicable.


