# Crèche News

# Singing Opportunity Young Voices 2021

After the success of this years visit to Young Voices in January we have once again provisionally booked 21 places to sing in the Young Voices 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebrations in 2021.

In brief, Young Voices (YV) describe their concerts '*This is not just any ordinary choir concert – your children will sing with many other children in a massive arena near you.* Young Voices uses the best sound, lighting, and production teams, making your concert as spectacular as any other arena concert. Your choir will sing a variety of music with amazing artists, from all different backgrounds.'

Due to the impact of Coronavirus Young Voices concerts will be slightly different this academic year and there will be no Arena concerts in January/February 2021. Instead there will be two events:

- An opportunity for us to join Young Voices in The Biggest Sing an attempt to break the Guinness World Record for the largest number of people singing simultaneously. This will be on Tuesday February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021 at 3pm in school, with a remote connection to all those participating in other schools;
- A Young Voices 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Concert. We have been allocated places on Tuesday June 8<sup>th</sup>
   2021 at FlyDSA in Sheffield all day, with a daytime rehearsal and a ticketed evening concert which family & friends can attend.

I would like to invite <u>all Juniors</u> who love singing to consider whether they would like to participate in these events.

# The Biggest Sing, February 2<sup>nd</sup>

As this event will be at school during the school day all those who sign up to participate in the YV concert on June 8<sup>th</sup> will automatically be included in this.

A Young Voices 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary t-shirt, or a YV t-shirt from a previous YV concert or a plain white t-shirt will need to be worn.

# Young Voices Concert, June 8th, Sheffield

- At the concert on June 8th we will sing approximately a dozen songs chosen by YV. The lyrics will be distributed to participants and will need to be learnt off by heart beforehand. *There are opportunities for songs to be practised at home using online resources and participants will be expected to join in with rehearsals in school, 3.30-4.30pm on Thursdays, after Easter.*
- We will travel to Sheffield in the school minibus/a small coach for which there may be a small charge. Singers will travel to Sheffield leaving school mid-morning. There will be a rehearsal at

the arena in the afternoon and the concert is from 7pm – 9pm (we will get back to school very late that evening).

- Young Voices requires all children to wear either their own plain white t-shirt, or a t-shirt with YV logo which may be from a previous year, or a new YV 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary t-shirt purchased through school (cost approx. £12.00).
- Family & friends can attend the concert as audience members audience tickets cost approx.
   £21 each & will be available via school nearer the time.
