#### **Dear Parents**

Further to my Holiday Club at Lady Lane Park School last year, I am offering the above dates for 2020.

My ethos is primarily to encourage children to step away from 'screens' and to get as much fresh air and exercise as possible, whilst learning new skills in the process. Ultimately, this is the children's holiday and I want them to have fun! I run a 'relaxed, easy going' club with great emphasis on safety, kindness and fair play towards each other.

#### **Activities proposed:**

Sports: eg. cricket, football, tag rugby, tennis, fun races and dodgeball.

Arts and Crafts: eg. painting, drawing, colouring, painting stones, making jewellery, decorating masks, bun decorating and more.

Creative Play: den building using boxes and sheets, water play, creating scenes with plastic animals and wooden bricks etc.

## RE: Music lessons - Clarinet and Alto Saxophone Taster Sessions

On Wednesday, the children from year 3 to year 6 watched a presentation on woodwind instruments with myself. I am now able to offer a free 'taster' session for your son/daughter at a suitable time during the school day.

If you would like your child to have a hands-on experience with the instruments and have a go at making sounds on them, then please fill in the form below and return it to the school office. Students will need to have a large enough hand span in order to play the instrument and may need to start on the clarinet due to the weight of the saxophone: but this is something that can be looked at during the taster session.

If your child would like to sign up following the taster sessions, I would advise a shared lesson of 20 minutes or a 20 minute solo lesson in the first instance and when each student has grown in stamina, the lesson lengths could be increased. Once each student reaches Grade 1 standard, then I would recommend that a full half-hour lesson is necessary.

Initially I would recommend hiring an instrument from Windstruments for the first term to see how they take to it before buying one.
