Admission arrangements and information for entry into Year 7, September 2022

Skipton Girls' High School undertakes its own selection testing. We are keen to make sure that all parents/carers in the area have all the information they need to make the best choice for their daughters' secondary school. It may be useful to note that every year, we are able to offer places to a significant number of girls who live outside our normal priority area. I have outlined below early notice of some of the important dates in the process and where to find further information.

Year 5 Open Evening for September 2022 entry, Wednesday 14th July 2021

Unfortunately, due to covid restrictions, we are unable to open the school to pupils and their parents this year. There will, however, be a Year 5 Virtual Open Evening available on our website (<https://www.sghs.org.uk/>) from the afternoon of 14th July.

We are hoping it may be possible to run 30-minute school tours for pupils and their parents in the coming weeks – max. 2 families at a time – however this will be dependent on the government announcement on whether restrictions will be lifted on 21st June 2021. Please check our website next week for an update on whether these tours will be able to go ahead.

Closing date for the registration form: by 4pm, Monday 30th August 2021

It is very important that if a parent/carer wishes their daughter to sit the selection tests, they should complete the online registration form by the above date. Without this, pupils will not be able to sit our selection tests and therefore, cannot be considered for a place at Skipton Girls' High School.

Selection tests will be held on Saturday, 25th September 2021

The selection tests will be held at Skipton Girls' High School from 9.15am until approximately 1pm.
