Young Voices update for parents of all Junior pupils:

Young Voices are staging 2 events in 2021.

The first is a **Guinness World Record Attempt for the Largest Simultaneous Sing-Along, on Tuesday February 2nd** at 2pm. As this event is taking place during school time, and will be done remotely at school with a live link to the O2 arena, **we have decided to involve all Junior pupils, who will automatically be included.** They will sing 'Lovely Day' by Bill Withers, with Billy Ocean, YolanDa Brown and Ruti streamed live from London. The current record is 293,978 people. We hope we can help Young Voices beat this!

The second event - we hope - will be a Young Voices concert in Sheffield on Tuesday June 8th.

Assuming this can go ahead it will be the usual all-day event, culminating in an evening concert which family and friends can attend. Pupils choose to attend this event and need to sign up for it with me, via Mrs Wright in the School Office. Further information on this will be available in the new year, in conjunction with government guidelines. We are delighted to already have several pupils who have signed up to attend.

Sickness Policy

Following Government guidance, in order to keep our school community safe, we will not be permitted to allow any pupil into school who is unwell. Please do not bring your child to school if they are unwell in any way.

Without exception, any adult or child showing signs of any illness will be required to stay at home until they have completely

recovered. If they or a member of their family are experiencing Covid-19 symptoms they will be required to follow government isolation and testing procedure guidance.

Should your child become unwell during the school day; we will contact you and your child will be placed in isolation, with an adult from their group, until you come to collect them. Please see the following Government statement at the end of this letter for procedures should anyone in our school community become unwell.

Please note that any pupils, who have had <u>sickness and/or</u> <u>diarrhoea</u>, **must** be kept away from school for a minimum of **48 hours** after the last episode as usual.
