Good afternoon to you all,

It has been a great relief to get our whole school community back in to school this week. School has been incredibly calm and it is clear everyone is happy to be back. I have been impressed with the attitudes of all our pupils, who follow all the handwashing rules in school brilliantly, even when they are desperate to get out to play! Could I politely ask that all adults ensure social distancing rules are followed when around the school grounds, it is still recommended that adults are between 1-2m apart when they are near one another. All pupils must bring a named water bottle in to school each day, we do not have spare water bottles and all our water fountains have had to be closed off due to COVID restrictions. Pupils can refill their own bottle at limited times during the day, but please send this in fresh and full each day.

Our Lady Lane Park Nursery is now welcoming pupils from immediately after their 2<sup>nd</sup> Birthday, if you think may want to use this provision, please do register your interest with Mrs Wright as soon as possible. Please don't forget that if you recommend Lady Lane to new families, and they join our community in any part of our school, you will receive a bonus of £500 (taken off your next term's fees). We do have limited places in different parts of school, so please do pass on any enquiries.

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> March is **Red Nose Day** and our Heads of School Council, Freddie & Holly, have been in discussions with Mrs Moffat about how we can raise money for this important charity. 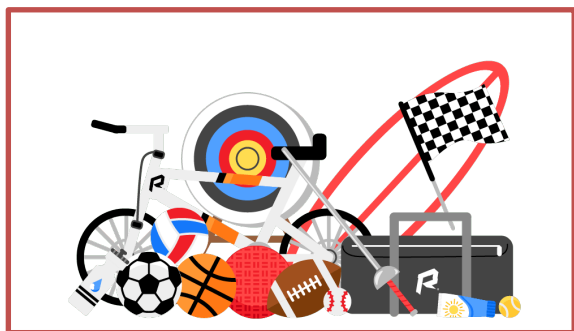
