Sports Day News

We are delighted to say that we have assessed the new guidance from Monday and can safely continue to have spectators at our annual Sports Day. In order for us to enable parents to watch Sports Day on Wednesday 23rd June (weather permitting) we have to limit spectators to 2 adults per family. On the day, Infant spectators will be able to access the field from 8.45am and Juniors from 1.15pm. On entry to Sports Day, we will ask you to arrive wearing a mask and to leave contact details for Track & Trace and you will be directed towards your seats. You must stay in your own seats and not swap seats with anyone else, once you are seated you will be able to take off your mask. Please be aware that we are not permitted to open the toilet facilities or provide refreshments.

We will be dismissing Junior pupils from the field at the end of the day, please have one adult collect your children from their 'Form area' at the field. If you are not spectating and your child is booked in to crèche we will walk the children to crèche.

We really do hope this can be a success as it will give us the opportunity to assess if it is safe to have spectators at our Summer Celebrations.

COVID Reminders

Please note that if your child has any symptoms (a high temperature a new, continuous cough or a loss or change of sense of smell or taste) you must ensure that you book an appointment to get a free PCR test for your child. In Bradford, you are also permitted to have other family members tested at the same time, even if they do not have symptoms. Remember your whole family must isolate whilst you await results.
