Non-essential shops, leisure and entertainment venues closed.



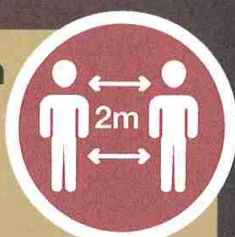
Places of worship will close apart from funerals and individual prayer.
