I hope to be able to expand the classes as soon as the restrictions are lifted so watch this space!

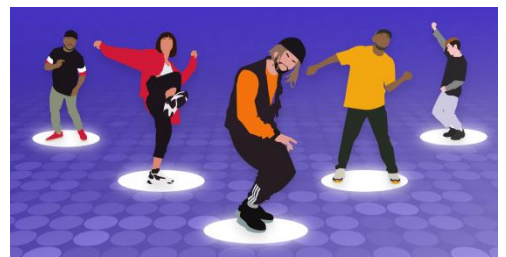
Please remember that to attend classes all forms must be completed and fees paid so please see me ASAP if you need replacement copies.

Music lessons – Brass Instrument Taster Sessions

Dear parents/guardians,

We are very lucky to be able to offer some more taster sessions for brass lessons here at Lady Lane Park School with Mr Bradnum, our Brass Teacher.

If you would like your son/daughter to experience a free 'taster session' of having a hands on experience with the instruments and making sounds on them, then please fill in the form below and return it to the school office. Ideally students should have their 2 adult front teeth before starting to learn a brass instrument.

The instruments on offer for the taster session are Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn and Euphonium. (other instruments can be learnt too following the taster session.)

If your children would like to sign up following the taster sessions, I would advise a shared lesson of 20 mins or a 15 minute solo lesson in the first instance and when each student has grown in stamina, the lesson lengths could be increased. Once each student reaches Grade 1 standard, that's when a full half-hour lesson would be advised. The fees are £32 per hour which works out at £8 for a 15 minute lesson and £10.67 for a 20 minute lesson.

Initially I would advise hiring an instrument from Windstruments for the first term to see how they take to it before buying one.
