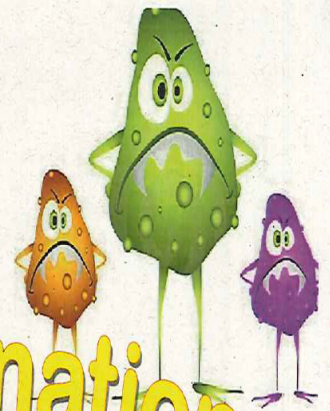
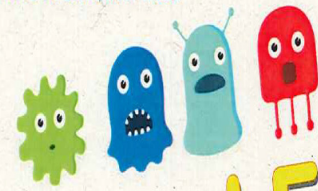

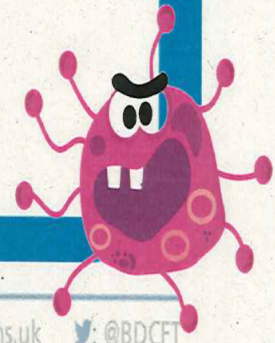
Nasal Flu Spray Vaccinations
