We are delighted to announce that we have a new brass peripatetic teacher hopefully joining us in the New Year. Mr Stephen Bradnum, BMus PGCT studied music at Huddersfield University before completing his Post Graduate Certificate of Teaching at Leeds University.

Mr Bradnum started singing with Halifax Young Singers at about 16 years old and trained him to initially take sectionals before finally giving him the opportunity to conducting Rutter's Requiem before he left. Stephen was the only successful applicant from the North of England, The other five being from the South! His main mentor was David Lawrence and he also took conducting Masterclasses with Bob Chilcott, Mike Brewer, Alan Simmons. He is also a brass peripatetic music teacher at Dixons City Academy and Rastrick High School. He also works with Musica Jazz (Musica Kirklee's Jazz Orchestra) who recently performed at the 'Music for Youth Schools Proms' at the Royal Albert Hall. Mr Bradnum also conducts the local Concert Band 'Hot Aire!' which celebrated its 30th Anniversary in June 2019. We are delighted that he has agreed to join our staff.

Lastly, we would like to congratulate Mrs Arnold who has successfully gained her Masters in Education from Leeds Beckett University. Her three year course has included work looking at the influences that have shaped modern education, from the philosophy behind teaching methods to government policies that direct educational practice. Mrs Arnold's final year research was focused on how teacher identity can shape change in Education. She has worked very hard to achieve this fantastic accolade and we are all delighted for her.

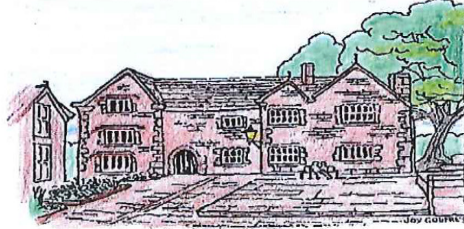
