### RE: Music lessons – Clarinet and Alto Saxophone Taster Sessions

On Wednesday, the children from year 3 to year 6 watched a presentation on woodwind instruments with myself. I am now able to offer a free 'taster' session for your son/daughter on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December** in the afternoon.

If you would like your child to have a hands-on experience with the instruments and have a go at making sounds on them, then please fill in the form below and return it to the school office.

Students will need to have a large enough hand span in order to play the instrument and may need to start on the clarinet due to the weight of the saxophone: but this is something that can be looked at during the taster session.

If your child would like to sign up following the taster sessions, I would advise a shared lesson of 20 minutes or a 20 minute solo lesson in the first instance and when each student has grown in stamina, the lesson lengths could be increased. Once each student reaches Grade 1 standard, then I would recommend that a full half-hour lesson is necessary.

Initially I would recommend hiring an instrument from Windstruments for the first term to see how they take to it before buying one.
